****HINT** Ask yourself: what are the conditions of the ICAO Standard Atmosphere? Those 4 conditions give you a surface temperature and lapse rate! Then just calculate the temperature up at 5,000 feet if you start at the ground level.**

****HINT** Remember your fractions... yeah. Math class comes back to haunt you when you want to fly airplanes. So remember, 8/8 means 8 full oktas. 5/8 means 5 oktas (of the 8 total) are covered by cloud--> broken clouds.**
